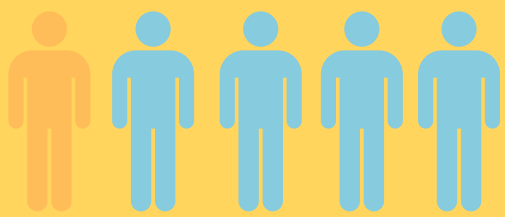

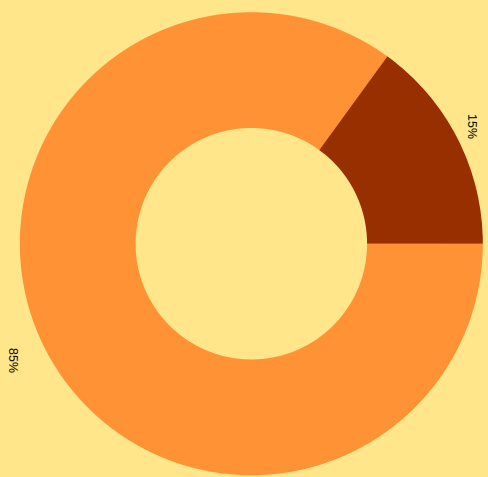
# 1/5

85% of students incarcerated are students with disabilities.

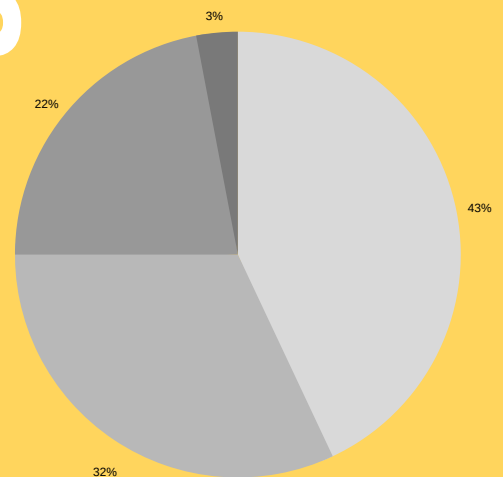
## JJS INCARCERATION
